IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR COMPUTER BASED TEST (CBT)
SCHEDULED TO BE HELD ON 06.09.2025 FOR THE POST OF SCIENTIST/ENGINEER 'SC'
(POST CODES : 20, 21, 22, 23)

1. The Candidates shortlisted for CBT can download their E-Admit Cards from 06.09.2025 onwards, for which a link will be provided on NRSC website.
2. The CBT shall be conducted in a **Single session** for all the posts. In case any candidate has applied for multiple posts, he/she may choose to appear for any **one** post duly verifying the eligibility criteria.
3. In case of any issues in downloading of E-Admit cards, candidates may reach out to the helpdesk either through mail/ phone provided therein on the website.
4. The Registration Number at the time of downloading E-Admit Card must be entered without hyphen (-). For eg: if the registration number is 2025-XXXXXXX, it must be entered as 2025XXXXXXX.
5. REQUEST FOR CHANGE IN TEST DATE/SESSION/CENTRE/VENUE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
6. The Question Paper consists of objective type questions as follows:

7. You will be given **90 minutes** to attempt **80 questions of Part-A**, **30 minutes to attempt 10 questions of Part-B**. Total duration of the examination is **120 minutes**.
8. If any candidate completes a session before its prescribed duration, the remaining time will **not** be carried forward to another session.
9. **The examination will begin with Part-A followed by Part-B. Part-A & B will automatically be submitted on expiry of prescribed duration of 90 minutes & 30 minutes respectively.**
10. For Part-A and Part-B, each question will have 4 options, out of which only one is the correct answer.

11. The questions which have been “**answered and marked for review**” will be considered as UNANSWERED and will not be evaluated.
12. Questions will be available in English and in Hindi. Candidate can click on the **View** in drop-down and select the desired language.
13. All candidates are requested to check remaining Server Time/Exam Duration displayed on their respective console as paper shall get submitted automatically on the completion of scheduled exam duration.
14. One question will be displayed on the screen at a time. For lengthy questions screen scroll option will be available.
15. Candidates may note that the Answer key will be released in respect of Part-A questions only within 2 days from the date of completion of CBT and the window for raising of objections, if any, will be opened simultaneously for a period of 3 days.

Guidelines for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities:

16. Candidates belonging to PwBD should produce the original Disability Certificate in the prescribed format [Annexure-I] clearly indicating the percentage of disability and issued by a Medical Board constituted by Central or a State Government, consisting of at least three (03) members out of which one shall be a specialist in the particular field of disability.
17. The facility of Scribe shall be allowed to any person with benchmark disability as defined under section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including that of speed if so desired by him/her.
 - a. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe shall be given, if so desired by the person.
 - b. In case of other category of persons with benchmark disabilities, the provision of scribe can be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of Government health care institution as per proforma at Annexure-II.
18. The person eligible for use of scribe under (i) above or (ii) above (with certificate as per Annexure-II) will be granted compensatory time @20 minutes/ hour, even if they do not opt for the scribe.
19. Persons with specified disabilities as defined under section 2(s) of the RPwD Act, 2016, having less than 40% disability, and difficulty in writing, have to produce certificate as per Annexure-III, to be eligible for use of scribe/ compensatory time.
20. The Candidate will have to arrange own scribe at his/her own cost.
21. The scribe may be from any academic stream. The qualification of the scribe should be one step below the essential qualification as prescribed for the post.
22. A person acting as a scribe for one candidate cannot be a scribe for another candidate.
23. The candidate will have to give a undertaking (Annexure-IV) confirming that his/her scribe fulfils all the stipulated eligibility criteria mentioned above. In case it later transpires that he/she did not fulfil any laid down eligibility criteria or suppressed material facts, the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the Written Test.

24. During the examination, at any stage, if it is found that scribe is independently answering the question, the candidate's candidature will be cancelled. The candidature of such candidates using the services of a scribe will also be cancelled if it is reported after the examination by the invigilator/supervisor/ observer that the candidate/ scribe has resorted to any such malpractices.
25. **NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE:** Candidates who are currently employed with Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous bodies etc. may appear for CBT strictly under intimation to his/ her employer concerned. Please note that NOC from the employer is mandatory at the stage of Interview. This requirement for NOC is also applicable to candidates who may gain such employment subsequent to appearing in CBT.
