MoU Signing between NRSC, ISRO, and Department of Justice, Ministry of Law and Justice

National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC), Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), and the Department of Justice (DoJ), Ministry of Law and Justice (MoLJ) signed the MoU for the third phase of the Nyaya Vikas project on October 11th, 2024. The signing ceremony took place in the presence of key officials including Dr. S K Srivastav, CGM, RCs, NRSC, and Sh. Gaurav Masaldan, JS, MoLJ, with Dr. Prakash Chauhan, Director, NRSC, joining remotely. Also present were Dr. Sameer Saran, DGM, RRSC-North, Khushboo Mirza, Akash Goyal from RRSC-North, Sh. Yashasvi Kumar, Director, DoJ, Gaurav Tripathi, and Prem Lata Kaushik from Department of Justice.

The MoU signifies the ongoing partnership between RRSC-North, NRSC, ISRO, and the Department of Justice to enhance the Nyaya Vikas platform. Nyaya Vikas utilizes geospatial technology to monitor the progress of judicial infrastructure projects funded under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for the Development of Infrastructure Facilities for the Judiciary across India.

During the program, Dr. Sameer Saran, DGM, RC-North, NRSC, ISRO, provided a comprehensive overview of Nyaya Vikas, highlighting its launch in 2018 and subsequent upgrades in 2020. He underscored NRSC's role in providing technical support and training to officials involved in the project. Dr. S K Srivastav, CGM, RCs, NRSC, reflected on the success of earlier phases of Nyaya Vikas, emphasizing its transformative impact on governance in the public sector, especially in managing judicial infrastructure. Mr. Gaurav Masaldan, JS, MoLJ, expressed appreciation for the ongoing partnership between the Department of Justice and RRSC-North, underscoring the project's significance in enhancing transparency in judicial infrastructure management. Dr. Prakash Chauhan, Director NRSC, reiterated NRSC's commitment to leveraging space-based technologies for national projects. He highlighted the MoU's importance in furthering collaboration between the ministries and assured continued support from NRSC for future initiatives of the Department of Justice. The program concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Yashasvi Kumar, Director, DoJ, who acknowledged the contributions of both NRSC and the Department of Justice, in the successful implementation of Nyaya Vikas project.
