## MoU Signing between NRSC, ISRO and Department of Posts on 22<sup>nd</sup> Aug 2024

To establish a standardized, geo-coded addressing system in India, the Department of Posts (DoP) has signed a pivotal Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) on 22nd August 2024.
