ISRO has established National Database for Emergency Management (NDEM) at National Remote Sensing Centre at the behest of Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi. The Committee of Secretaries (CoS) has entrusted the responsibility of implementing NDEM to Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), and National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) is the lead agency to implement and operationalize NDEM. NDEM is conceptualized, designed and developed by NRSC as a unique national level geo-portal to disseminate space based inputs addressing all natural disasters in all phases along with the services of disaster forecasting organisations like IMD, CWC, GSI, etc. NDEM emphasizes on organizing Multi-scale geospatial database for the entire country using spatial integration procedures, hosting of services for situational assessment, develop Decision Support System Tools for Disaster Risk Management in the country. NDEM has been providing services to MHA, NDMA, State DMS Organisations and all DM professionals working in the country. NDEM is fully operationalized and working towards achieving the Prime Minister's 10 point agenda in building Disaster Resilient Society.

NDEM has undergone several progressive changes and the latest version of NDEM version 4.1 has been designed and developed and released by Honorable Union Minister of State, Ministry of Home Affairs during 3rd NPDRR, Delhi, 11th March, 2023. For the continuous support of NDEM in Disaster Risk Management in the country, NDEM has received Geospatial Excellence Award 2023 during GeoSmart Conference on 19 October, 2023 at Hyderabad.


